

Internet Access

During the conference you can use the Wireless Internet Service if your laptop is equipped with an internal or external WLAN card, which uses the **802.11b** or the **802.11g** communication standard. The 802.11a type of cards won't work, because they use another frequency.

You can reach the Wireless Internet Service on the ground floor of the main building.

How to configure your Windows XP to be able to use the internet:

1. Create a new wireless network profile:

Start menu Settings Network Connections
Double click on the "Wireless Network Connection"
Add a new preferred network by clicking "Add..."
Use the following settings:

- Network name (SSID): **Cornet**
- Authentication Type: **Open System**
- Security Mode: **Disabled** (Data encryption/WEP disabled)
- IP-address: **Automatic** (DHCP)

2. Create a Virtual Private Network (VPN):

Start menu Settings Network Connections
Click on "New Connection Wizard"
Choose the "Connect to the network at my workplace", and click Next.
Choose the "Virtual Private Network connection", and click Next.
Write the name of the connection (i.e. Corvinus VPN)
Host name or IP address is: **vpn.bkae.hu**

3. Restart your computer – maybe you don't need it, but to be sure.

4. Double click to your new VPN connection, and connect to the Internet:

Login: jovokut

Pass: *****(you will receive it at the registration desk)

You can also use the Internet in the computer lab (Room 116) of the "Sohaz" (next to the main building to the left when leaving along the Danube). Login and pass are the same as above.

The opening time of the lab:
